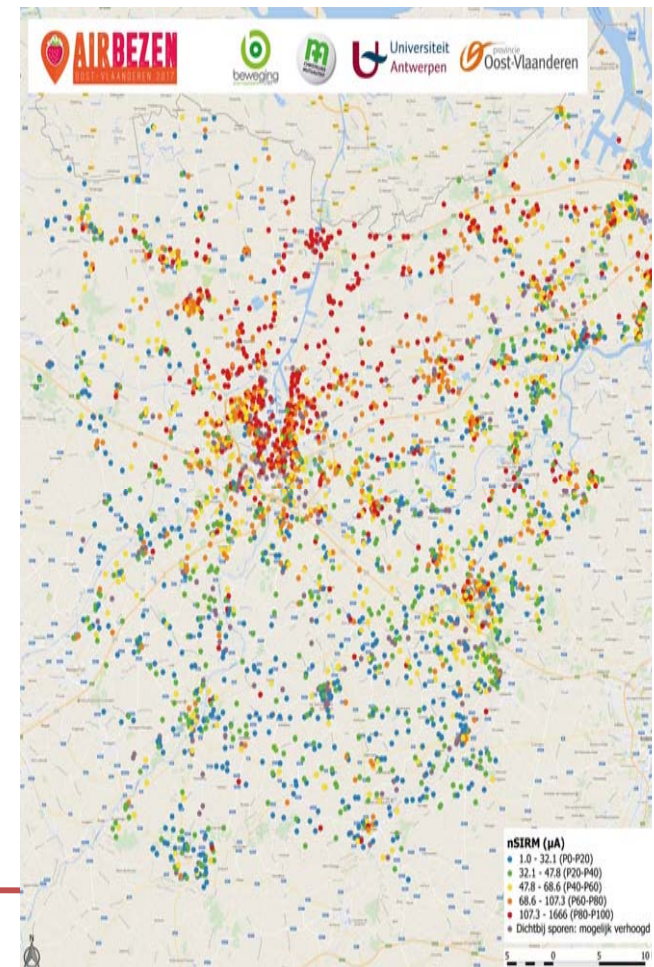
The University of Antwerp is well-known in Belgium for its citizen science projects, mainly on air quality

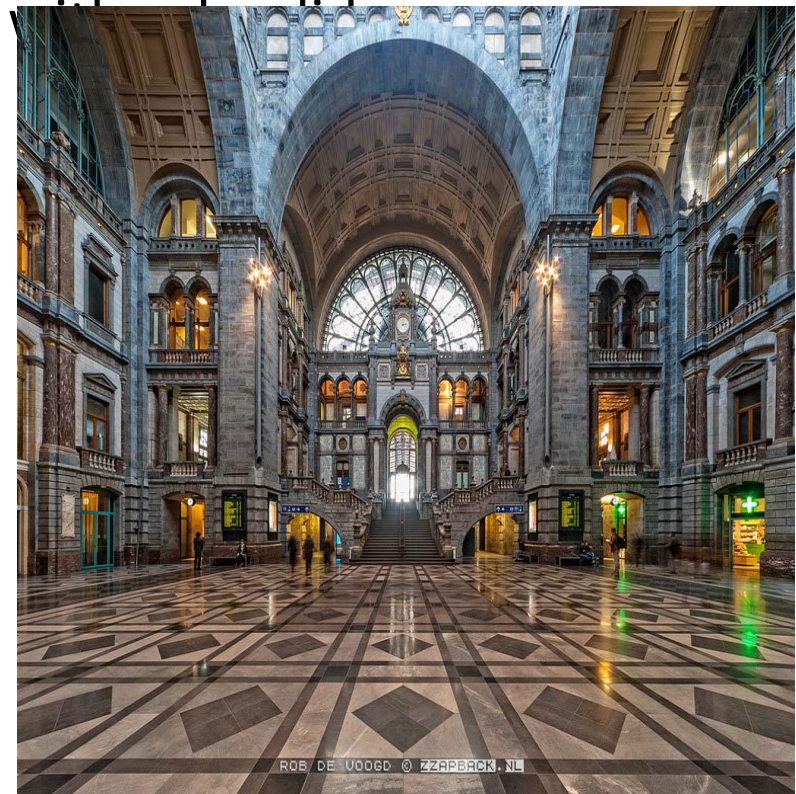
